## **Hempstead Mayor Waylyn Hobbs Appointed to NYCOM's Policy Committee on Community Revitalization**

Mayor Waylyn Hobbs of the Village of Hempstead has been appointed to serve on the Community Revitalization Policy Committee of the New York State Conference of Mayors (NYCOM). NYCOM's President, Mayor Francis X. Murray of the Village of Rockville Centre, made the appointment.

As a member of the Community Revitalization Policy Committee, Mayor Hobbs will be directly involved in providing policy recommendations to the NYCOM Executive Committee, developing positions on various pieces of legislation, and considering new legislative proposals that will benefit cities and villages. This committee will consider a wide range of issues, including local economic development, Main Street initiatives, abandoned property, land use, property maintenance and government operations.
